

Our Council Club chef Gloria Meyers' father is a World War II veteran. The Club also is the meeting place for a World War II Veterans Historical Society and a chapter of the Seratoma Club. Gloria mentioned the Veterans Honor Flight Program to some of our members and asked for our assistance with a fund raising activity to send veterans on the honor flight. We made our ballroom available for a chili cooking contest on Oct.23, 2016 with seventeen entries and served three hundred visitors who paid ten dollars admission for the chili lunch and entertainment after the contest. The complimentary chili was provided by the contestants. Several World War II and Korean War veterans were present. Entertainment was provided by a teenage girls acapella group that sang war period songs (Boogie Woogie Bugle Boy, In the Mood, Moonlight Serenade, etc.) and the Boy Scouts of America Central Indiana Council Band that played patriotic music. Many Knights and their families were patrons of the event and were encouraged to become active with our Council. This was an unusually successful first time event. The proceeds were adequate for our Grand Knight to present a check for the cost of sending three veterans on an Honor Flight.
