- Thanked everyone for support during past year. The President presented a gift on behalf of the Chapter in appreciation to Dave Rihm for his 17 years' service as Treasurer.

### Committee Reports:

- Baseball Night – It was reported that we now have two drivers for the buses and 170 tickets have been sold. The cost for the package with dinner, beer and soft drinks, and transportation has been kept at \$10.00, but the actual cost is more than that. CIC member support will be needed to keep the attendee cost at \$10.00. Residents of Gibault will attend. A Knight made a generous donation of \$150.00 to help cover the cost of hosting Gibault residents and staff at the game. Gibault Children's Services will be recognized during 7<sup>th</sup> inning stretch. Member councils are asked to help defray the actual cost of the game event as \$10 does not cover the true cost. The State Deputy and Lady will attend. Motion to cover any additional Gibault cost up to \$100 carried.
- 40 Days for Life – The next campaign will begin in September. The Chapter will continue Saturday Knights for Life for the fall campaign and 13 councils participated. The goal is to have Knights present for all hours on Saturdays and for the first and last two hours on weekdays during the campaign. Other areas have Knights covering all the evening hours in campaigns that run 24/7 for 40 days.
- The Columbians will be reconstituted. Now have about a dozen living members and they are over 70 years old. Robert Newport, Brian Keith and Walt Peycha are already committed to reviving the Columbians as a communications and recruiting tool. Looking for good Catholic men who like to sing to join.
