The most powerful weapon against evil is Prayer. God has granted us the ability to follow his word and to do his work. We must pray for the power of the Holy Spirit to guide us in our actions. In order that prayer works rests with our faith in God and the knowledge that what we do pleases Him and can only bring us closer to Him.

THE ACTION
