Key Areas I Focus On

- Safe Environment: My top priority is protecting our children. Please visit kofc.org/safe
 for all Safe Environment resources. Please ensure that your councils Grand Knight,
 Program Director, Family Director, and Community Director for the 2025-2026 Fraternal
 Year have had their names submitted to Supreme on Form 185 (GK) and Form 365
 (Directors) for this fraternal year and they are actively looking out for e-mails from
 donotreply@praesidiuminc.com.
- Home Corporations: If your council has a Home Corporation, please ensure you have Terms-of-Use and Charitable Distribution agreements in place (refer to Handbook #10155). Send new agreements to me. Remember, Home Corps need their own incorporation, EIN, and insurance, separate from your council.
- Council Insurance: Every Subordinate Council needs its own insurance. Lockton Affinity is a recommended and economical provider that the Officers Desk Reference suggests: 1-800-496-0288 or councilinsuranceprogram.com.
- Annual Tax Reporting (Form 990): Councils must file their Form 990 non-profit tax returns each year. Councils with less than \$50,000 income have a simple online option. Home corporations file separately with their own EIN.
- Legal Matters: Consult the Officers Desk Reference and the Charter, Constitution, and Law booklet (Form 30) for common issues. Contact me if further assistance is needed.
- **DO NOT Incorporate Your Council:** The Supreme Advocate's Office advises **against incorporating subordinate councils**, despite potential pressure from banks or state gaming commissions. I'm here to clarify if you have questions.
